What issues do you think aren't getting enough attention from media or elected officials? How would you seek to remedy that through your campaign or when elected?

It is reasonable to focus on salmon recovery because doing the things necessary for salmon will benefit the county in many ways, including: preservation of green space for bird populations and human enjoyment; preservation of open space for farming; flood control; orca survival; pollution control; ground water protection and augmentation; stream flow protection; irrigation water protection; and land use planning that keeps development out of dangerous places

Q16

What are your 6-month and long-term priorities with the King County Conservation District around conservation in King County and how would you achieve them?

Six month: maintain good supervision of the finances, grant application reviews, and support the continuing excellent conservation programs in agriculture assistance, water conservation, erosion control, salmon habitat enhancement, storm runoff control, reforestation, urban tree canopy, and responsible productive gardening.

Long term: help diminish the urban heat island problem by encouraging and facilitating green roofs and green walls; help diminish erosive stream flows by getting more stormwater into the ground via rain gardens and facilitation of low impact development and redevelopment.

How do you plan to bring awareness about conservation and KCD in the urban, suburban, and rural areas of King County?

We should use earned media attention to help presently unserved residents of the benefits of our Native Bareroot Plant Sale and Guide to Native Planting, and all the information helpful to gardeners, farmers, and property owners in our Better Ground webpages.

Please explain the intersection between racism, poverty, and climate change, and discuss how you would apply and prioritize Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in decision making.

Racism promotes the self-defeating concept that one is better off with a nasty or foolish person of one's own race for a neighbor, boss, or leader, than one would be with a decent person of a different race in those types of positions. This keeps our society functioning at a level way below its potential by putting marginally productive or even harmful people in positions of power, and by preventing highly qualified individuals from serving in influential or potentially productive positions. The ramifications of this creates poverty for racial minorities at a large scale, and low economic performance for the wider community at a huge scale. Climate change will impact impoverished people more intensely and rapidly than well-off people both by causing poor people to live in hotter areas and without conveniences and products that money can buy, and by diminishment of the public service functions of the environment.
